

### **Behaviour Consultation**

Up to 2.5 hours

This is held at your home or remotely (e.g. over zoom). During the behaviour consultation, I ask lots of questions regarding your dog, their history, background and behaviour. I then discuss the diagnosis of the behaviour, including what I think has caused the behaviour to develop. We then discuss strategies to help manage the behaviour, including any safety concerns.

# **Behaviour Report**

You will then be sent a tailered behaviour report both through the post and over email detailing all we discussed during the consultation. This includes the behaviour diagnosis, causes, safety risks, and strategies to manage the behaviour.

This will accompany any additional training materials and information in a supplementary pack.

A copy of the report will also be sent to your referring vet, along with any necessary communications to discuss medical aspects of the case.

### Follow-up Appointment

#### 1-hour

Depending on the nature of your dog's behaviour problems, this will either be held at your home, in a park, field, secure dog field or remotely. During the follow-up session, we discuss progress, any questions or concerns you may have, and we will discuss (and maybe practise) any necessary behaviour modification training.

After this, additional follow-up appointments can be booked for an additional £40/session

You will also be provided with remote support in the form of email, phone calls or text for up to 3 months after the consultation.

# Step 1: Get in touch

# Step 2: Choose a date and time

You will be sent a list of dates and times to choose for the behaviour consultation appointment.

# Step 3: Payment

Once a date has been chosen, either full payment or a 50% deposit is required for the booking to be secured. This payment must be made no less than 1 month before the consultation date.

Please note: The 50% deposit (or 50% of the full payment made) will not be refundable if you decide to cancel your booking within 5 calendar days of the arranged consultation date.

DID YOU KNOW? Your pet insurance company may be able to reimburse you the consultation fee

# Step 4: Veterinary Referral

I require a signed referral form from your vet before the consultation can take place. The referral form will be provided to you to give to your vet to sign, and must be returned as soon as possible. Your vet may first want to check your dog over for any signs of pain or medical issues that could be affecting the behaviour.

#### Why is this important?

Many behaviour problems are caused or affected by pain or medical issues. These issues may not be obvious, so it's important your vet rules this out before I provide a behaviour diagnosis and treatment plan.

# **Step 5: Questionnaire**

You will be required to complete and return a questionnaire regarding your dog at least a week before the consultation.

I have a first class BSc (Hons) degree in Animal Behaviour & Welfare from Harper Adams University. - Working in boarding kennels
- Work in a rescue centre for a year, including work with dogs with behaviour and training issues and implementing training plans
- Assisting in dog training classes
- Watching and leading dog consultations under the supervision of Certificated Clinicial Animal Behaviourists (CCAB's)
- Providing behaviour consultations as an associate behaviourist for 'Second Nature Behaviour Ltd' for two years.

#### I follow a strict code-of-conduct

Unfortunately, the dog behaviour and training industry is currently unrelgulated. This means that anyone can set themselves up as a dog behaviourist or trainer, no matter what their qualifications, experience or training methods include.

- I am a Candidate Member for the 'Fellowship of Animal Behaviour Clinicians', and am gaining the experience necessary to gain full accreditation as a Certificated Clinical Animal Behaviourist (CCAB).
- I only work on veterinary referral, to rule out pain or medical issues contributing to the behaviour before I provide advice.
- I use the most scientific up-to-date methods, involving reward based training. I do not advocate the use of punishment, and I value safety and welfare above all.






#### Polite note:
